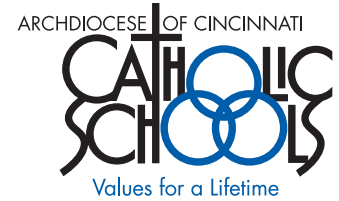

## HIGH TEST SCORES

### Terra Nova

The U.S. Department of Education has recognized the Catholic schools of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati for consistently ranking in the top 10% of schools in the nation for scores from 8th grade reading and math tests.

## SCHOOLS FOR ALL

Catholic schools welcome students from diverse academic, social, economic and religious backgrounds.

16% are of other faiths.  
16% are minorities.

Cincinnati: 66% of inner city students are of other faiths and 64% are minorities

Dayton: 55% of inner city students are of other faiths and 60% are minorities

Research shows that students from disadvantaged backgrounds have a far greater chance to succeed in Catholic schools than anywhere else.

## GRADUATION RATE

### Archdiocese of Cincinnati

75% of Catholic elementary students enter a Catholic high school

98% of Catholic high school students graduate

### Greater Cincinnati

76% of Catholic elementary students enter a Catholic high school

98% of Catholic high school students graduate

### Greater Miami Valley

71% of Catholic elementary students enter a Catholic high school

99% of Catholic high school students graduate
