The Cincinnati Media Center is now “home” to a new science resource for Archdiocesan classroom teachers, Science Library Packs!

Science Library Packs are sets of 4-8 hard and soft cover books specially selected to **support the grade level environmental and life focuses** of the Archdiocesan Graded Course of Study for Science. Each set contain books that can be used by the teacher to read aloud to the class, to introduce topics, or to be read by students for further study.

Science library Packs can be picked up (sorry, we cannot mail them) from the Media Center. Dayton and Northern area schools can request them from Cincinnati, and they will be delivered to the northern Media Centers.

Science library Packs may be checked out for **three weeks**. Arrangements to keep the books longer may be made if there is no request pending by another school.

Science library Packs must “travel” as sets. Individual titles cannot be selected from various packs.
