

RCIA CATECHIST CERTIFICATION

OPTION A

1. Complete required theology courses (Live, Video-assisted, [VLCFF](#), [LPMP](#) or college) and other requirements for Basic Catechist Certification.
2. Complete either “Introduction to Catechetical Ministry” (Live or Video-Assisted) if working with children
or
“Adult Catechetical Process” (Live) if working with adults.
3. Fulfill other requirements and apply for Basic Catechist Certification.
4. Complete the required theology courses (Live, Video-assisted, [VLCFF](#), [LPMP](#) or college) for General and Advanced Catechist certification.
5. Complete three (3) skills for General Certification and three (3) skills for Advanced Certification by attending RCIA related workshops.
6. Fulfill other requirements and apply for General and then Advanced Catechist Certification as requirements are completed.

OPTION B

1. Complete the theology courses of the certificate option of the [LPMP Program](#).
2. Complete the OEC Course, “Sacraments” (Live, Video-Assisted, [VLCFF](#) or college).
3. Complete either “Introduction to Catechetical Ministry” (Live or Video-Assisted) if working with children
or
“Adult Catechetical Process” (Live) if working with adults.
4. Complete six (6) skills by attending RCIA related workshops.
5. Fulfill requirements and apply for Advanced RCIA Catechist Certification.
