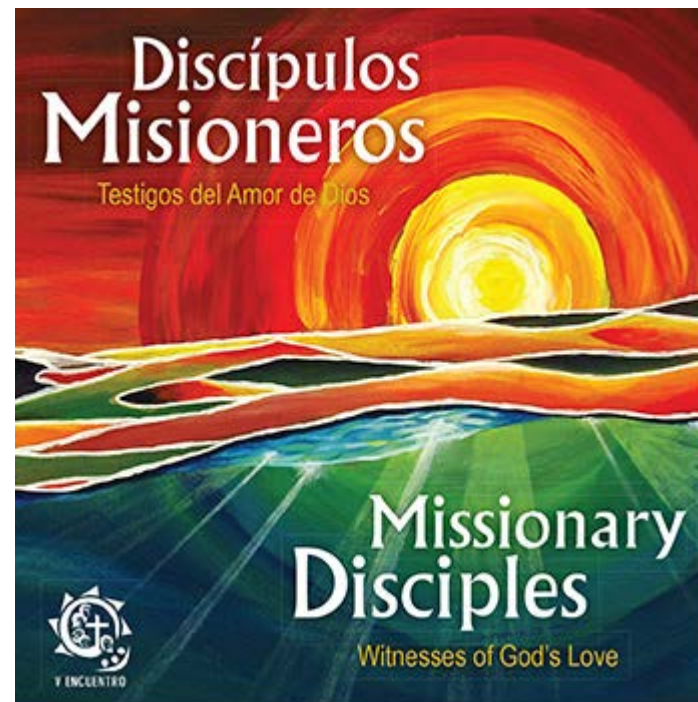


### Prayer of Pilgrims
