Multiply Your Ministry is designed for experienced church leaders who are responsible for recruiting, orienting, training, nurturing (and sometimes firing!) volunteers for ministry.

Course content applies to virtually any ministry setting that utilizes volunteers for ministry: catechesis, youth ministry, pastoral ministry, worship, peace and justice, etc. All are welcome to take the course: youth ministers, catechetical leaders, pastoral ministers, even pastors.

If your role, in part or in full, is to multiply your ministry through the heads, hearts and hands of others, then this course is for you. Check out course objectives on the reverse.

Matriculated UD students:
