_____ Certificate of Recognition

This adult recognition is offered by the Catholic Committee on Scouting in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. It is designed to recognize those adults whose attention to the twelfth point of the Scout Law, A Scout is Reverent, is undeniable. The candidate should show a history of fostering the religious aspects of Scouting especially at the unit level.

There is no limit to the number of Certificate of Recognitions presented in a given year.

_____ Bronze Pelican Award

This adult award is offered by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati in conjunction with the National Catholic Committee on Scouting. It is designed to recognize those individuals who are actively involved in youth ministry through Catholic Scouting. The candidate should have a strong history of support for the youth religious emblems programs, a strong history of involvement with Scouting under Catholic auspices, or have influenced the spiritual development of youth and scout unit alike.

Typically 15 to 20 Bronze Pelican Awards are presented each year.

_____ Saint George Emblem

This recognition is offered by the National Catholic Committee on Scouting (NCCS) for accomplishments and sustained dedication to any of the following areas. It is not presented based on a certain number of years spent in Scouting.

- Promoting the religious emblems programs for Catholic youths or serving as a counselor, moderator or coordinator. Encouraging non-Catholic youths to participate in the religious emblems programs of their own faiths.
- Giving notable service in promoting Catholic activities and service projects for the church and being willing to serve on committees for those purposes.
- Actively participating in and promoting Scout retreats and days of recollection.
- Giving notable service in organizing and maintaining Catholic-chartered Scouting units including multiple units where needed.
- Giving notable service in bringing Catholic programs and activities to those youths not in Catholic-chartered Scouting units.
- Using fully one's general Scouter training as well as "Scouter Development" to provide an outstanding Catholic Scouting program for youths.
- Encouraging appropriate ecumenism and Catholic leadership within the various Catholic-chartered Scouting units.
- Providing leadership in promoting Scouting for all youths regardless of race or creed. Helping organize Scouting units for minority and disadvantaged youth.

Typically 5 to 10 Saint George Emblems are presented each year. The number presented is determined by a NCCS formula.
