The Worship Office and Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry welcome your participation in the 2008 edition of our exciting annual program, *Laudate*. We know you will represent your parishes and schools well during our days together. We expect you to show Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to everyone and the property around you. We are confident you will display the maturity, responsible leadership and character that are trademark qualities of Catholic youth. Thank you!

Participants will:

- Show Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to everyone and to the property around them through language, dress and behavior
- Refrain from inappropriate touching and verbal harassment
- Dress appropriately outside of sleeping quarters (no display of bellies, underwear, spaghetti straps, or advertising of alcohol or drugs).
- Attend all scheduled activities, arriving promptly after breaks and staying for the entire event
- Adhere to stated curfews
- Remain on the grounds of the retreat center at all times
- Remain inside the building after dark
- Respect the “lights out” time as a time for quiet so others can sleep
- Follow directions given by the leadership team throughout the event
- Report problems to an adult

Participants will not:

- Possess weapons of any kind
- Possess, consume or distribute alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or illegal drugs
- Engage in any form of sexual activity or peer sexual harassment, physically or verbally
- Engage in actions that could result in injury and/or damage to property
- Visit in sleeping areas with the opposite gender at any time

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct could result in immediate expulsion from the program. I have read the above code, and will conduct myself accordingly throughout the Laudate event:
